The overarching objective of this position is to support the National Geospatial-Intelligence Agency (NGA) in its overall mission of providing timely, relevant, and accurate geospatial intelligence in support of national security. The Expeditionary Operations Office (DOE) plans, deploys, and sustains GEOINT capabilities for military and civilian expeditionary and crisis operations, to include the domestic environment. - Six (6) years of specialized experience in the Transportation Logistics field in support of NGA, DoD, DoS, or other similar agencies/entities.
- Eight (8) years of experience in supporting transportation of personnel, equipment, and supplies, including but not limited to: providing licensed operators for tactical and non-vehicles, providing certified operators for Material Handling Equipment (MHE) on site (such as forklifts up to 15K, 5-ton trucks, and 30 passenger busses), coordinating the transportation of customers, equipment, and supplies, packaging and Crating supplies and equipment, inspecting cargo and mail both for compliance and movement eligibility, arranging for transportation of hazardous materials, cargo, mail, baggage, etc, inspecting transportation activities and making recommendations on corrective actions as needed, assembling, palletizing, and transporting aircraft cargo loads, completing appropriate transportation-related forms such as: travel forms, weight and balance records, international tariff rates, etc, preparing Load Plans, conducting air traffic management activities, providing all reports required to track personnel and equipment transiting the CENTCOM AOR, and ensuring vehicles are properly fueled
